**TWO COUNT INDICTMENT**

The Jurors of the Grand Jury for the County of Sandusky and the State of Ohio, on their oaths, in the name and by the authority of the State of Ohio, do find and present that:

**COUNT ONE**

On or about the 15th day of June, 2012, in Sandusky County, Ohio, MARC D. GLOTZBECKER, being a public official, did knowingly commit a theft offense, to wit: Marc D. Glotzbecker did, with purpose to deprive the City of Fremont, the owner, of six (6) Cedar Point tickets beyond the scope of the express or implied consent of the City of Fremont. The said City of Fremont being a municipal corporation or political subdivision of the state.

This being in violation of Section 2921.41(A)(2) of the Ohio Revised Code and against the peace and dignity of the State of Ohio.

**THEFT IN OFFICE – A Felony of the Fifth Degree**

**PENALTY:** The penalty for this offense is a sentence of not less than six (6), seven (7), eight (8), nine (9), ten (10), or eleven (11) months nor more than twelve (12) months and/or a fine of up to \$2,500.00 and defendant is forever disqualified from holding public office, employment, or position of trust in the State of Ohio.

**COUNT TWO**

Between the 4th and the 7th day of November, 2011, in Sandusky County, Ohio, MARC D. GLOTZBECKER, being a public official, did knowingly commit a theft offense, to wit: Marc D. Glotzbecker did, with purpose to deprive the City of Fremont, the owner, of three hundred thirty-nine (\$339.00) dollars beyond the scope of the express or implied consent of the City of Fremont. The said City of Fremont being a municipal corporation or political subdivision of the state.

This being in violation of Section 2921.41(A)(2) of the Ohio Revised Code and against the peace and dignity of the State of Ohio.


**THEFT IN OFFICE – A Felony of the Fifth Degree**


**PENALTY:** The penalty for this offense is a sentence of not less than six (6), seven (7), eight (8), nine (9), ten (10), or eleven (11) months nor more than twelve (12) months and/or a fine of up to \$2,500.00 and defendant is forever disqualified from holding public office, employment, or position of trust in the State of Ohio.

**NOTICE TO DEFENDANT**

You are notified that you are under indictment for a charge or charges which may place you under a weapons disability pursuant to R.C. Section 2923.13, which prohibits a person under indictment from knowingly acquiring, having, carrying, or using any firearm or dangerous ordinance during the pendency of this case OR upon conviction of the charged offense(s) or lesser offense(s). If you violate R.C. Section 2923.13(A) while under indictment, you may be charged with Having a Weapon While under Disability, a felony of the fifth degree.
