Re: State of Ohio vs. Randall J. Daley, 13-CR-0094

Yesterday Randall J. Daley was sentenced to a total stated prison term of six (6) years on two counts of endangering children (2nd degree felonies) and one count of kidnapping (1st degree felony) for the abuse of a child on July 8-10, 2011 at Pelton's Trailer Park near Fostoria. The sentence was handed down by Visiting Judge Hein. Seneca County Prosecuting Attorney Derek W. DeVine had recommended that the Court impose a sentence of twenty-two (22) years at the sentencing hearing.

The twenty-two month old child had been initially treated at Fostoria Community Hospital and then transferred to Toledo Children's Hospital. The child suffered serious physical harm including extensive bruises on her face, arms, legs, back, and torso. She also had suffered a first degree burn over a significant portion of her body after being held in a hot bath.

Mr. Daley's then girlfriend, Tellina Tenney, had been convicted for her role in the abuse in 2012 and is serving a fourteen (14) year term of imprisonment. Ms. Tenney testified against Mr. Daley at his trial.

The case had initially been investigated by Fostoria Police and then transferred to the Seneca County Sheriff's Office. Mr. Daley was represented by Tiffin attorney Mark Klepatz.
