Re: State of Ohio vs. Tellina Tenney, Case #11CR0201

Today Tellina Tenney was sentenced by Seneca County Common Pleas Court Judge Steve C. Shuff to a prison term of fourteen (14) years on her conviction to two (2) counts of Child Endangering for her role in the July 2011 abuse of a child in her home in Pelton's Trailer Park near Fostoria, Ohio. Tenney and her then boyfriend, Randall Dailey, had been caring for a 22 month old child for several days.

"The Seneca County Sheriff's Office and the Fostoria Police Department are both to be credited for their hard work and diligence in this investigation", said Derek W. DeVine, Seneca County Prosecuting Attorney. According to DeVine the investigation continues. Anybody who may have additional information about this matter should contact Detective Sgt.
